what you'll need

- Bubble Bag kit including blotting screens
- 1 or 5 gallon bucket or 20 gallon garbage can
- Cold water and ice
- mixing options: a spoon, hand mixer, or Bubble Now machine & bag
- A dish towel
- Plant material

caution & care

If you are using an electric mixing device, we recommend mixing in a separate bucket before pouring the mixture into your Bubble Bags. Please refer to the care instructions included with your bags in order to preserve your bags and to qualify for our warranty against manufacturer's defects.

the process

The original Bubble Bag system offers you eight layers of industrial grade filtration, which will allow you to extract the essential oils from almost any plant.

STEP 1

Line the bucket with your Bubble Bags, starting with the 25 micron bag and ending with the 220 micron bag.



STEP 2 option 1 mixing by hand



2.1 Fill the bucket with enough **cold water** to cover the bottom of the Bubble Bags (about halfway full).



2.2 Add your **dry or frozen** plant trimmings.



2.3 Add enough **ice** to almost fill your bucket to the top.

2.4 Stir your mix for **15 to 20 minutes**, adding ice if necessary to keep the water **cold**. A 50/50 mix of ice and water is ideal.



STEP 2 OPTION 2 mixing with bubble now machine

** These instructions are for the 5 gallon machine. Please see important tips below on using the 20 gallon machine.*

2.1 Place **plant material** in the Bubble Now bag. Add enough **ice** to fill the bag, then **place the bag** into your Bubble Now machine.



2.2 Fill your bubble Now machine with **very cold water** and **ice**, up to the line marked "H" inside the unit.

2.3 **Turn on** your Bubble Now machine. You can adjust the time to your desired setting. We recommend **5 to 15 minutes maximum**.



2.4 When the Bubble Now has finished mixing, there is no need for settling to occur. Using the drain hose, **drain the water into your Bubble Bags**, which you prepared in Step 1.

2.5 **Gently squeeze** any remaining water out of the Bubble Now Bag. **Rinse down the inside** of the bag to make sure no plant extracts are stuck to the inside. **Drain the rinse** water into your Bubble Bags.



STEP 3 pulling the bags

3.1 Now you are ready to begin collection of your herbal extract. **Pull out the 220 micron bag** and allow the water to drain into the remaining bags. Discard the contents of this bag as the 220 micron bag is used only to catch contaminants.



3.2 The remaining bags contain various grades of extract. **Pull out each Bubble Bag**, one by one, draining them **back into the bucket**.

3.3 As you pull each bag, **turn it inside out** and **stretch it over a bowl**.

Scrape your herbal extract off with a spoon or plastic card.



3.4 Place your extract **onto a blotting screen**. Fold a clean, dry, dish towel in half with the blotting screen in the middle. **Gently press out the moisture**.

20 gallon machine tips

If you have purchased the 20 gallon machine, please take into account the following considerations:

- We recommend using the "Soft" setting, although some people prefer to use the "Normal" setting.
- The Bubble Now XL has a drain pump. To operate the pump, switch the Wash & Drain selector to "Drain" and turn the wash timer on.

- The Bubble Now XL can be filled with water to about 6" below the top of the washing chamber.
- We recommend installing a drain tap or plug into the bottom of the garbage can that holds your 20 gallon Bubble Bags. This way you can drain the water out of the bags without lifting them with the strain of the excess heavy water, which is much easier, and will prolong the life of your bags.
